Important Reminders for VoVi Convention 2001 "Courage and Practice"

Dear Friends,

Some members of our Organization Committee visited the Disney Magic at the beginning of January, and had the opportunity to discuss immigration issues with the Disney immigration staff.

Please remember to have all necessary papers for embarkation as follows:

(1) Those with a Canadian or US citizenship should bring their passport, and it must be valid for 6 months at least since 1 November 2001, i.e., the passport should expire after May, 2002.

(2) Those with the following citizenship: France, Germany, Australia, Belgium, Denmark, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Monaco, Norway, Singapore, Switzerland, United Kingdom, are allowed to visit the United States without a visa if your stay is under 90 days. You will need the following papers for embarkation:

- A valid passport (that does not expire before May, 2002)
- Your roundtrip airline ticket (optional)
- Your **I-94W** (this paper is issued to you by the Immigration Office upon entry into the United States)

(3) US Permanent residents (green card holders) should bring their Green Cards, valid until end of 2001.

Note: If your green card has expired, you will have to pay a penalty of 340 USD.

(4) Those who reside outside the United States and have the following citizenship:

VietNam, Laos, Cambodia, or China, should contact your local American Consulate to apply for a Multiple Entry Visa (B2 Visa) into the United States. **It is very important to get a Multiple Entry Visa.** You also need a passport valid till May, 2002 at the minimum. The following embarkation papers are required:

- A valid passport with Multiple Entry Visa (B2 Visa)
- **I-94** paper issued to you when entering the United States.

Our organization committee strongly urges you to take note of the necessary papers for embarkation, since we will not be able to help at the last minute if your papers are not sufficient. The Disney Magic will need to leave on time on Saturday, 27 October, 2001.

We will announce the hotel prices for staying before and after the Convention in the coming weeks. We strongly recommend that you plan to come one day earlier on Friday, 26 October 2001, so that we can arrange for transportation from the hotel to Port Canaveral in the morning of Saturday, 27 October 2001.
