Dear VoVi Friends,

After the completion of the VoVi Congress "Courage and Practice" on the Disney Magic cruise ship last November 2001, we have worked tirelessly in order to find a convenient location for the 2002 VoVi Congress under the compassionate guidance of Master Tam. How great is our joy when Master Tam visited and agreed to select the location of the next VoVi Congress "Weapon of Love" at the Wyndham Greenspoint Hotel, in Houston, Texas, at the end of October 2002. Located in the South, Houston is the largest city of Texas with a population of more than 1 million 600 thousands, and one of the second largest Vietnamese community after Los Angeles, California. Houston also has numerous restaurants and malls owned by Vietnamese and Chinese people, and the Vietnamese settlers warmly welcome concerts and musical performances.

The VoVi Congress "Weapon of Love" will last from October 10, 2002 to November 5, 2002. It includes 3 day dedicated to the VoVi Congress, 1 day for attending the VoVi Spiritual Concert (Thien-Ca) (Costs for the concert ticket and transportation will be announced later), and 1 day dedicated to the celebration of the 80th birthday of our dear Master.

The months of October and November are high-season months in Houston, Texas, with many visitors and conferences because of its moderate and warm climate compared to the other states in the East and North of America. For these reasons, we sincerely urge you to register early and pay a deposit of 150 USD per person before April 1, 2002, so that we can estimate the number of participants more accurately and request more hotel rooms if available.

In addition, the hotel only has a total of 120 non-smoking rooms for triple or quadruple occupancy with a large King size bed and one full-size sofa bed. The remaining rooms are standard double rooms with 2 full size beds for 2 adults or maximum 2 adults and 2 children under 10 staying with their parents. Please notice in case we cannot satisfy your request to have a room for triple or quadruple occupancy.

We hope that you will join us in the celebration of the 21st VoVi Festival "Weapon of Love" so that we can rejoice together from the blessings of the Lord, and be reunited with our dear Father to wish him a happy birthday.
