Questions and Answers about the 2002 VoVi International Congress "Weapon of Love"

1) What kind of sightseeing is there in Houston?

In the city of Houston, you can visit the NASA Space Center, the Galleria Shopping center, many museums, the Houston Zoo etc. In Galveston, which is about 1 hour 45 minutes drive from Houston, you can visit the Moody Gardens with the Aquarium, the IMAX theatre, and even go to the beach if the weather is warm.

Houston also has a large Chinatown area (HongKong4) about 45 minutes from the Hotel. This Chinatown is as large as the Bolsa area in Los Angeles with many restaurants where you can taste authentic Vietnamese cuisine. There is also an old Vietnamese quarter with street names like Nguyen Hue, Ham Nghi, etc, which will remind you of the city of Saigon.

2) Do the Registration Fees for the VoVi Congress include meals?

The registration fees cover 12 meals as follows:

- On the 3 days of VoVi Congress: 31 Oct, 1-Nov and 2-Nov: 3 meals per day at the Hotel (breakfast, lunch and dinner)
- 3-November: Spiritual concert day: Breakfast will be served at the Hotel We currently plan to transport people to the Chinatown area, where you can have meals on your own. Details to be specified later in the Congress guide.
- 4-November: The celebration of the birthday of Master Tam. Breakfast and dinner will be provided. Lunch will be on your own.

Note: Those who book for early arrival before 31 October or who stay after 4-November: The hotel prices include room charges and taxes only, without breakfast.

3)	If there are no more executive king suites, will there still be rooms for quadruple occupancy? In order to provide greater comfort to our VoVi friends, we have suggested that you register early and select the Executive King Suite which include 1 King sized bed and 1 full size Sofa bed for triple or quadruple occupancy. However, the remaining rooms are Standard Double rooms with 2 full size beds and can still accommodate 4 people (if they are not too large).
