A permanent resident of the United States is required to carry their Alien Registration Card for boarding.

Every person (including children) must specify their birthdate, passport number and nationality (citizenship) because of the regulations of the cruise company.

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: 01 February 2004 or sooner if fully booked
