29-February 2004 ANNOUNCEMENT ABOUT THE VO-VI CONGRESS "DIVINE LOVE AND INFINITE GUIDANCE"

Dear Vo-Vi friends,

After a month of intensive work with the cruise line, we have completed the transfer of all registered Vo-Vi friends to the new ship, and we have been able to provide better prices for a great number of people as follows:

- All Vo-Vi friends registered for the DOUBLE Inisde B/C categories now have one single price of 1095USD/per person instead of 1135 USD or 1180USD (incl. 160\$ port taxes, 4.16% Hawaii tax, 70\$ gratuities to cruise staff and cruise itself).
- 2) A large number of Vo-Vi friends have been transferred to lower rates cabins, to the maximum number that we could request in order to reduce your cruise prices. The Organization Committee will notify the Vo-Vi friends directly who have received a lower rate.
- 3) Since the design and infrastructure of the Pride of Aloha differs from the Pride of America, the Organization Committee cannot accommodate all the original requests for Triple Balcony. We have contacted the Vo-Vi friends who volunteered to choose a lower rate cabin or transfer to an oceanview cabin.

IMPORTANT DEADLINES

1) The deadline for deposit 1 payment is past due **(1 February 2004).** The Organization Committee will not guarantee that space can be held for those who did not pay their first deposits.

2) The deadline for deposit 2 payment is **31 May 2004** (before 1 June 2004).

3) The Organization Committee needs to know the number of guests staying before and after the Congress at the Ala Moana Hotel. Please notify us as soon as possible before 15 April 2004. Full hotel payments should be made by **31 May 2004** (before 1 June 2004).

4) Please notify the Organization Committee of your transportation needs **before 30 June 2004** (see separate registration form).

We have a special excursion program for the Hawaiian Islands and Oahu **on 5 September 2004** when the ship arrives back to port (see separate announcement).

Looking forward to see all of you again at the Vo-Vi Festival "Divine Love and Infinite Guidance" in Honolulu and on the Hawaiian Islands.

Excursion Program "Divine Love and Infinite Guidance" Congress 2004 in Oahu, Hawaii, Kauai and Maui

Deadline for registration and full payment for excursions: 15 April 2004 or sooner if sold out. There is no refund in case of cancellation.

1. Sunday 5 September 2004: Aloha Pier – Honolulu, Hawaii (Oahu):

Note: This program is reserved for Vo-Vi friends having flights departing after 6:30PM on 5 September 2009, or will stay overnight at the Ala Moanha Hotel on 5 September 2004. Vo-Vi friends having earlier flights have the option of taking a taxi from the Pier to the Airport directly.

10:00 – 10:30: Gathering luggage and boarding buses.

10:30 – 12:30: Small circle island tour of OAHU. Stop at Hanauma Bay –where Elvis Presley starred in the "Blue Hawaii" movie, on the way to Chinatownn, stop at the Blow Hole and Pali Lookout (to have a full view of Oahu). 12:30 – 14:30 : Lunch on your own in Chinatown Honolulu.

14:30 – 15:00: Back to Ala Moana Hotel. Check-in at hotel.

Vo-Vi friends returning on 5 September 2004 with flights departing after 18:30PM will be transferred to the airport according to the list of advance registration with the Organization Committee. Usually, you will be picked up for airport transfer 3 hours in advance of the flight departure time at the KONA Tower – Ala Moana Hotel. You can wait in the Hotel Lobby or the Hospitality suite.

Fees for small circle island tour and airport transfer on 5 September 2004: 20 USD per person (same price for adult and children).

Vo-Vi friends registered to stay at the Ala Moana Hotel on 5 and 6 September 2004 do not pay the excursion fees and airport transfer fees.

II. 5-day Excursion Program on the islands Kauai, Hawaii (Hilo/Kona) and Maui:

Fees: 80 USD per person (same price for adult and children). Free for child under 2yrs old.

Since we cannot transport a too large number of people to one beach or for sight-seeing at the same place, the Organization committee can only offer 200 seats for the excursion program for Vo-Vi friends who register early and pay the full fees. Vo-Vi friends who do not choose this excursion program can select a large array of shore excursions offered by NCL (please visit their website at <u>http://www.ncl.com/shorex/index.htm#</u>) for more information. Currently excursions are only offered for the Norwegian Star but they will be offered for the Pride of Aloha in the future).

Monday 30 August 2004: Stop in Kauai Island

Opening Ceremony in the morning. Lunch on ship. 14:00 – 17:30: trip to Poipu Beach, one of the world renowned beaches.

<u>Tuesday 31 August 2004: Ship leaves Kauai at 1PM (all onboard no later than 12)</u> Excursion on your own. Please return to ship no later than 12. Conference program in the afternoon.

<u>Wednesday 1 September 2004: Stop in Hilo (Big Island) and departure at 6PM</u> Conference in the morning. Lunch on ship. 13:00 – 17:00: Visit Volcano Park (Admission ticket included) and orchid gardens.

<u>Thursday 2 September 2004: Stop in Kona (Big Island)</u> 8:00 – 12:00: Scenic ride and Mauna Kea beach. Lunch on ship. Conference in the afternoon.

Friday, 3 September 2004: Stop in Maui 8:30 – 12:00 : Trip to Kamaole Beach Conference in the afternoon

Saturday, 4 September 2004: Depart Maui at 6PM

Closing Ceremony in the morning. Lunch on Ship.

13:00 – 17:00 : visit lao needle, Maui tropical plantation, and stop in Lahaina town, picturesque town, for shopping before going back to ship.

NOTE: Program can be modified according to the advice from Master Tam, or weather reports, or changes in itinerary/program from the cruise ship.

III. Information about ALA MOANA Hotel and Program on Saturday 28 August 2004 and Sunday 29 August 2004

The Ala Moana Hotel is located next to the Ala Moana Shopping Center, the largest shopping center of Honolulu with over 240 shops of all kinds. From the hotel take the 2nd floor walkway and in 5 minutes, you will be in the shopping area. There is a large selection of restaurants and in particular the International Food Court offers a wide variety of ethnic cuisines (Thai, Chinese, Korean, Japanese, Italian, etc). There are a couple of French bakeries with mouthwatering selections for breakfast.

The shopping center hosts the major bus stop area. Each bus ticket costs 2 USD one-way(1 USD for senior citizen). You can take the bus to Chinatown or visit the surroundings by bus. Tour buses also stop at the Ala Moana Hotel. Please inquire at the Information Desk for tour options.

From the hotel, there is a 5-minute walk to the Ala Moana Beach Park, a public beach area with 77 acres, jogging paths, a sandy beach area with showers and toilet facilities.

Program Saturday 28 August 2004

13:00 – 21:00: Meeting Room – Ala Moana Hotel

Vo-Vi friends receive cruise tickets, badges and other conference materials (gift for Vo-Vi convention, Vo-Vi religious books, etc), guidance with registration in case incomplete information submitted for passport/visa/immigration issues. 23:00 – 1:00 : Common meditation to prepare for the spiritual congress "Divine Love and Infinite Guidance"

Program Sunday 29 August 2004

10:00 – 13:00 : Transfer in groups of 50 people with bus leader to the Aloha Pier. Check/verification of luggage in Kona Tower before handling over to bus company for direct transport to the pier.

Note: Vo-Vi friends staying at the Ala Moana hotel will check-in on the ship as one VOVI group. They do not need to check-in 2 times (one time for luggage and one time for cruise ticket because luggage is transferred directly to the cruise ship).

NOTE: Program schedule may be modified slightly based on the final count of passengers to transport and the check-in time specified for the VOVI group on the ship.
