IMPORTANT DEADLINES

- 1) The deadline for deposit 2 payment is **31 May 2004** (before 1 June 2004).
- 2) The Organization Committee needs to know the number of guests staying before and after the Congress at the Ala Moana Hotel. Please notify us as soon as possible and full hotel payments should be made by **31 May 2004** (before 1 June 2004).

- 4) Please notify the Organization Committee of your transportation needs **before 30 June 2004** (see separate registration form).

IMPORTANT DOCUMENTATION

Boarding the cruise ship is similar to boarding an airplane, and everyone is required to have proper documentation.

Please make sure that you have the following documents for boarding:

- 1) US Citizens require a passport valid 6 months beyond the sailing date (i.e. till March 2005) and a government issued valid ID like a driver's license. The government ID is only required for passengers over 16 years old.
- 2) US permanent residents must bring their ARC (Alien Registration card) and a government issued valid ID. The government ID is only required for passengers over 16 years old.
- 3) Vo-Vi friends residing outside the United States must have a passport valid 6 months beyond the sailing date (i.e. till March 2005).
- 4) Vo-Vi friends with citizenship from: France, Germany, Australia, Belgium, Denmark, Italy, Japan, Luxembourg, Monaco, Norway, Singapore, Switzerland, and United Kingdom do not require an entry visa into the US if residing less than 90 days. You may be required to present your airline return ticket to the Immigration agent upon arrival to the US.

NOTE

Since October 1, 2003, all citizens listed from countries in section 4) must have a machine readable passport. Otherwise, they will require an entry visa into the U.S.

- 5) Vo-Vi friends residing outside the U.S. and not belonging to the list of countries in Section 4) should contact the U.S. Embassy or U.S. Consulate in their country of residence to apply for an entry visa into the U.S (Usually a visitor visa of class B-2 with one or multiple entries).

- 6) All children accompanying their parents must have a separate passport – even for infants under 2 who are going with their parents.

The organization committee will not be held responsible in case you are denied boarding for lack of proper documentation. The Cruise Ship will NOT REFUND any cruise fares because of denied boarding.
