Q: How should we cultivate ourselves spiritually in order to succeed in our spiritual perfection?

A: To be a true spiritual adept, we should engage ourselves in spiritual perfection by accepting to practice patience and resignation within modesty and a constructive spirit.

A: To practice the method incorrectly and put the blame on Vo-Vi is truly creating a sin for oneself. Q: Why do earthly people like to criticize and gossip?

He repents his past mistakes, and sincerely abandons the deceitful promises, in order to practice and perfect himself spiritually with his own efforts.

Knowing that at our origin, we are truly ignorant, We turn within to correct ourselves and cultivate ourselves spiritually to dissipate our blindness, No more blinded by passions and agitation, our heart attains the dharma,

Q: What does "Ouán-Âm" mean?

"Quán" means to see, "Âm" means the sound of darkness, i.e., a being able to listen to the laments on suffering and the wishes of humanity, and who becomes touched and wants to provide them salvation and guidance. Similarly to the predecessors guiding the way to the followers, we repent ourselves on our own and correct our mistakes to cultivate ourselves spiritually in order to advance toward reaching equilibrium in our consciousness, instead of praying for favors at any time. Earthly people are greedy and even pray The Boddhisattva Kwan Ying when they buy lottery tickets for winning the lottery. If by chance, they win, they wrongly believe that this is a blessing from Buddha, and they create a bad habit of taking advantage of Him. They have no way to escape from greediness and lust. If they do not accept to engage themselves in perfecting themselves spiritually and rectifying their mistakes, their karma will become heavier each day, and they will not be able to resolve it. In the contrary, the Vo-Vi practitioner practices the method to release his difficulties with his own efforts, and he is not afraid of conflicts due to the earthly relations with their ungratefulness. We should practice in order to clearly see the sublime dharma of Great Compassion, and continue to develop ourselves with the practice.

With spiritual practice, we will resolve the problems without worries and sorrow,

To wish for anything only brings restlessness, We only cause agitation for ourselves without a way to escape,

The Celestial Mechanism truly exists, and our soul must travel across with its own efforts.
